

## Urgent incidental findings

Radiologists may spot an urgent incidental finding in a ZMBBI MR scan. “Urgent” is defined as a Level IV (Class A1) acute abnormal finding, which means the participant needs immediate medical evaluation today (e.g. emergency room). In these situations, the radiologist will do the following:

Immediately contact the PI of the study. The PI’s name is on the report, and their phone and email is in the Columbia directory. Tell the PI the following info:

– the subject ID

–the incidental finding

--the PI’s next task: get the participant’s name and contact info, contact one of the MDs who do follow-up calls, and tell the MD the incidental finding, the name, and the phone number.
